The Commissioners of Elections would like to inform voters that Election Day will take place on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 and poll sites throughout the County will be open 6am to 9pm.

Orange County will be participating in Early Voting for the 2020 General Election. Voters will have the ability to exercise their right to vote during a nine-day period before Election Day at any of the seven locations throughout the County. The following sites will be open to process any registered voter in Orange County: City of Newburgh Activity Center, 401 Washington Street in the City of Newburgh, Cornwall Ambulance Building, 1 Clinton Street in the Town of Cornwall, Middletown Senior Center, 62-70 West Main Street in the City of Middletown, Warwick Town Hall, 132 Kings Highway in Warwick, Village of Montgomery Senior Center, 36 Bridge Street in Montgomery, Delaware Engine Company #2, 22 Hammond Street in the City of Port Jervis, and Monroe Town Hall, 1465 Orange Turnpike in Monroe.

Early Voting will be conducted daily at the seven locations during the following dates and times: Saturday, October 24 from 12:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Sunday, October 25 from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Monday, October 26, from Noon – 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 27, from 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 28, from Noon – 8:00 p.m., Thursday, October 29, from 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Friday, October 30, from Noon – 8:00 p.m., Saturday, October 31 from 10:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m., Sunday, November 1 from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Dates to remember for the General Election: The last day to register to vote is Friday, October 9, 2020. Last day to apply for an absentee ballot by mail is Tuesday, October 27, 2020 and deadline to apply for an absentee ballot in person at the Board of Elections is Monday, November 2, 2020. Last day to return and postmark the ballot to the Board of Elections is Tuesday, November 3, 2020.
